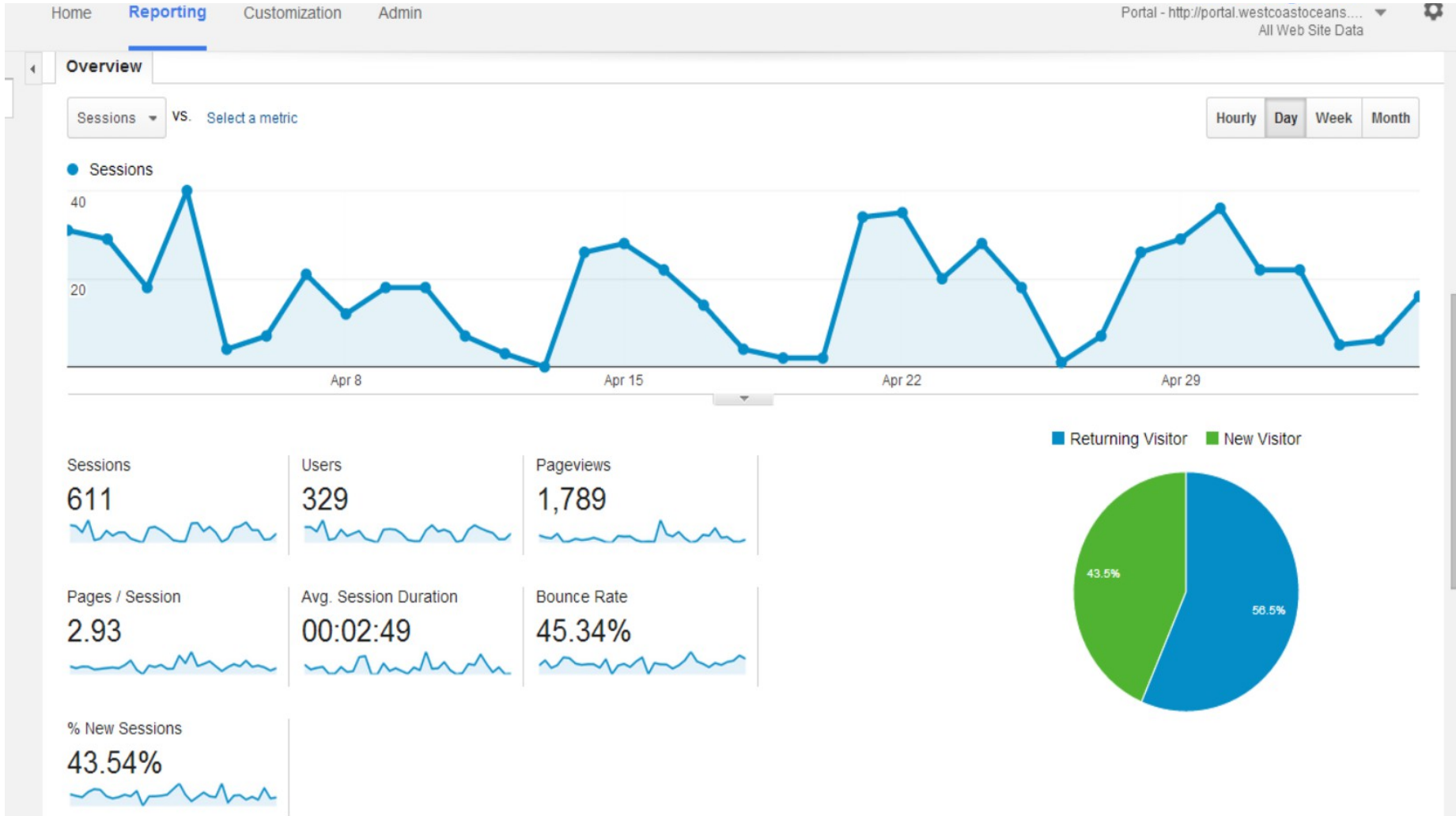

## Case

  - ▶ Need help with some federal sources (USFWS, NOAA, USGS)

# Grants Update



- **Extension Request**
  - 1 year, expand scope of work, extend hosting and coordinator contract, no extra cost
- **Task 6 SOW - Network Technical Assistance - 85K**
  - One contractor, work one on one with partners
  - Assistance with metadata, data, catalog, or service enhancements
  - Connections to state, federal, and regional portals
  - Refine best practices documentation, trainings
- **Task 6b - Portal Improvements – 20K**
  - Point97 is amenable to including this with their current contract

- Survey/RFP released – May 15 – June 15
- Proposal Review: June 16-30
- Contract negotiations: July 1-7
- Work Commences: July 15
- Work ends – Sept 2015
